

With mini-skirts, bouffant hairdos and dancing Barbies, this Nutcracker is a hilarious and delicious take on the classic Christmas tale.

Transposed to a kitsch 1970s home, where the Christmas tree is plastic, a yule log burns on the TV, the maid has attitude and the party guests do the bump, this is pop culture fantasy come to life.

Episodes of Noël naughtiness share the spotlight with the tender unfurling of childhood fantasies and first love. Snowflakes, reminiscent of a child's dream of winter, of ice cream and snowballs dance in the sky.

Returning to E. T. A. Hoffmann's original story, and impeccably faithful to the complete Tchaikovsky score, *The Hard Nut* is at once a send up of conventional *Nutcracker* stagings but also an homage to its Russian roots.

Featuring 33 dancers, the 53-piece Royal Ballet Sinfonia, a choir and full staging this is a rare opportunity to see *The Hard Nut*. Due its large scale, the show has previously been seen in only four cities worldwide.


Bus 19, 38 & 341 stop outside Sadler's Wells. 4, 30, 43, 56, 73, 153, 205, 214, 274, 394 & 476 stop at or near Angel tube station.

Leaves 8 mins after each main auditorium evening performance - £1.50 (£1 travelcard holders).
