As part of their comprehensive Luminato Artist Residency, the internationally acclaimed dance company Mark Morris Dance Group will perform *Mozart Dances*, *Liebeslieder Waltzes / Grand Duo* and *All Fours / Violet Cavern*.

DANCE FOR PARKINSON'S DISEASE

In 2001, the Mark Morris Dance Group began leading weekly dance classes for people with Parkinson's disease and their caregivers. Dancers and persons with Parkinson's disease both need to stretch and strengthen their bodies, use eyes, ears and touch to control movement, and constantly work on balance.

During the Luminato Festival, Dance for Parkinson's workshops will be offered with live accompaniment. Participants can discover the joy of movement.



ACTIVITIES

Dance is a way that people express themselves by moving to sound and rhythm. What makes you want to dance?

Try to dance as though you're moving through a giant vat of sludge. Pretend your legs are sticking to the floor as you try to lift them up.

Imagine that your arms are heavy weights. Now think about how difficult it must be for people with physical limitations to move and dance.

Play a cd at home and try moving around in a way that expresses how the music makes you feel. Change the song and see how it inspires the way you want to move.


