

To date, Mark Morris has choreographed over 100 works both for his own company, the Mark Morris Dance Group, and for other major companies including the San Francisco Ballet and American Ballet Theater. In doing so, he has established himself as the most original, intelligent and accessible choreographer working in dance today.

With live instrumentalists and singers, this rich and thrilling feast for the senses is pure theatrical magic.


