## DIRECTIONS

Ojai is 90 miles northwest of Los Angeles, 35 miles southeast of Santa Barbara, and a 20-minute drive inland from Ventura.

### FROM LOS ANGELES & FURTHER SOUTH

Take the 405 Freeway north, to the 101 west to Ventura. Exit the 101 at Highway 33. Follow the 33 into the Ojai Valley; merge onto Ojai Avenue. Proceed into town.

### FROM SANTA BARBARA & FURTHER NORTH

Take the 101 Freeway south to Ventura. Exit the 101 at Highway 33. Follow the 33 into the Ojai Valley; merge onto Ojai Avenue. Proceed into town.

**Scenic route option:** Take the 101 South to Route 150 and exit (Casitas Pass Road). Follow the 150 directly into Ojai. *Note: this route is not recommended in rain or at night.*

### FROM SANTA CLARITA & INTERSTATE 5

From Interstate 5, take Highway 126 west to Ventura. Merge onto the 101 north in Ventura. Exit the 101 at Highway 33. Follow the 33 into the Ojai Valley; merge onto Ojai Avenue. Proceed into town.

**Scenic route option:** From Interstate 5, take Highway 126 to Santa Paula. Exit 10/Highway 150. Take the 150 to Ojai.

## HELPFUL TIPS

### GET READY

Get a head start by participating in **OjaiU**, our free online class, to get you deeper into the music. You can also read Festival program notes and listen to music samples. Visit **OjaiFestival.org** for details.

### WHAT TO WEAR

Comfortable casual wear is entirely appropriate. Since this is an outdoor facility and the weather is often very warm, we recommend a hat or visor and sunscreen. A heavy wrap, sweater or jacket may be desired for the evening concerts.

### WHERE TO EAT

You'll find a great selection of restaurants walking distance from Libbey Bowl. For a quick bite, there will also be food and drink vendors at Libbey Park. Our Gathering Place is a nice place to bring a picnic and relax between concerts. Alcohol is not allowed in Libbey Park and Libbey Bowl.
