Morris complements the program with a work danced to the string quartet music of Henry Cowell, performed by the extraordinary American String Quartet.

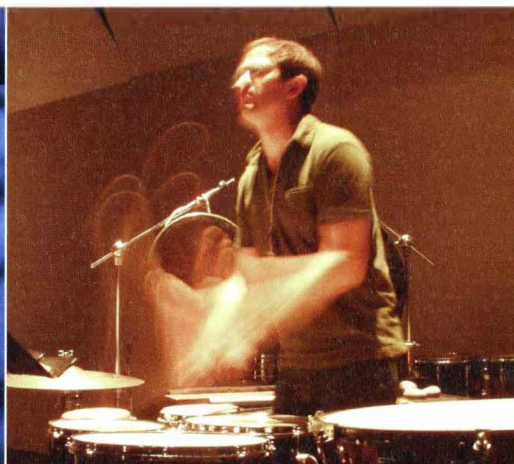

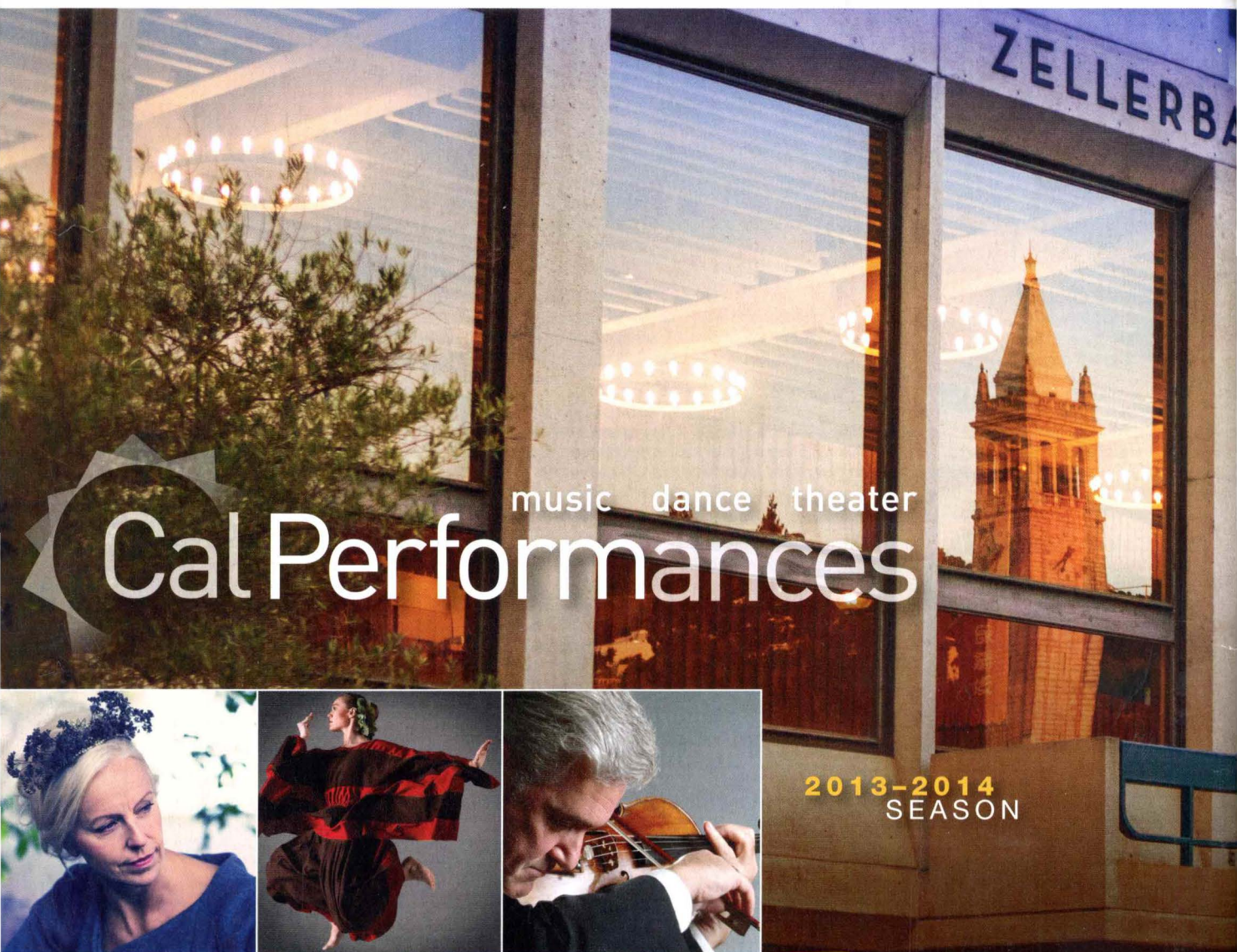
