Mark Morris was born in Seattle, Washington, where he studied with Verla Flowers and Perry Brunson. He performed with a variety of companies in the early years of his career, including Lar Lubovitch Dance Company, Hannah Kahn Dance Company, Laura Dean Dancers and Musicians, Eliot Feld Ballet, and the Koleda Balkan Dance Ensemble. He formed the Mark Morris Dance Group (MMDG) in 1980, and has since created over 90 works for the Dance Group, and over a dozen commissions for ballet companies. From 1988-1991 the Mark Morris Dance Group was the resident company of the Theatre Royal de la Monnaie in Brussels, the national opera house of Belgium. After three years in Brussels, the Dance Group returned to the United States in 1991 as one of the world's leading dance companies. Mr. Morris was named a Fellow of the MacArthur Foundation in 1991, and he is the subject of a biography by Joan Acocella (Farrar, Straus & Giroux). Mark Morris is noted for his musicality in choreography and has worked extensively in opera. The Dance Group won the Laurence Olivier Award for Best New Dance Production in 1997 for its British premiere performances of *L'Allegro, il Penseroso ed il Moderato* with English National Opera.

After years of worldwide touring and performing, the Mark Morris Dance Group celebrated its 20th anniversary with a three-week season at the Brooklyn Academy of Music, and the company moved into its first permanent headquarters in the U.S. In fall 2001, MMDG will open the Mark Morris Dance Center in Brooklyn, New York - a three-studio, 30,000 square-foot edifice. This Dance Center will provide a permanent home and rehearsal space for the Dance Group, and will foster the expansion of the company's outreach activities. For the first time MMDG will establish a dance school for children and adults, and institute a rental subsidy program that will provide local performing artists with low-cost rehearsal space. The Dance Center will be a hub of creativity for children, community residents, and professional dancers.
